Proposal for Program Changes related to M. S. in Technology Work Performance Improvement Graduate Certificate Program

Background: Faculty members teaching in the area of Training and Development (T&D) and the Work Performance Improvement (WPI) Graduate Certificate Program began meeting in Fall of 2008 to stabilize the course offerings for students electing those focus areas. Initially all faculty teaching courses related to these areas were invited to the meetings. By Spring of 2009 the regularly attend faculty members consisted of: Drs. Thomas Hawkins, Lance Hogan, Luke Steinke and Deborah Woodley. Preceding those meetings, undergraduate curriculum revisions to the core course for the Career and Organization Studies (COS) program make it necessary to revise the graduate curriculum to better serve the needs of all graduate students selecting these TD and WPI options. One problem was that a required course (COS 4840) for the WPI certificate became a core COS course the previous year. Another problem identified was the overlap of materials among several of the course listings. The changes listed below outline proposed changes to the WPI Graduate Certificate Program.

Procedure: In an effort to clarify and delineate required courses, a grid was established for content areas related to both the T&D area and the WPI Certificate. Major concepts, skills, and theories for both were discussed and placed on the grid.

Recommendation for WPI: The Work Performance Improvement Certificate should holistically focus on entities outside of formal training processes that improve performance in the workplace. The list of electives will specifically focus on performance issues not related to training.
