The proposed program changes include changes in the course number for Workshop in Music.

Change from MUS 4980 A,B,D to MUS 5200 A,B,D

Teachers enrolled in the MA in Music, Music Education Concentration are required to complete a minimum of 5 credits of MUS 4980 Workshops in Music. Originally, we were interested in allowing upper level undergraduate music students to possibly register for and enroll in 4980. However, as the program has evolved over time, we no longer wish to allow this option. Assignments in the courses are designed for working music educators and aren't accessible to our undergraduate students. Discussions are also geared towards the teachers and it is confusing to include the undergraduate population in these conversations. Therefore, we would like to change the number for Workshops in Music to the 5000 level and restrict enrollment to graduate students enrolled in our MA in Music program.

• Change title of the program from "Concentration" to "Option." This changed was requested by the Graduate School to facilitate proper billing of students.
