## **III.** Executive Actions

- 1. Dean James Johnson, CAH, requests the following course revisions from the Art Department be approved by executive action to be effective Fall 2008:
  - a. Change: The Master of Arts in Art Program seeks to allow repetition of selected courses in the program up to three times for credit. For each of the courses listed below the statement "May be taken twice for credit" will be replaced with "May be repeated three times for credit." Course descriptions will remain the same.
    Rationale: To allow graduate student to take 18 semester hours in a single studio area. This change will allow the academic transcript to accurately reflect student's course of study, reduce the number of independent studies and waivers, and make the graduate coordinator's advisement responsibilities less complex. Repeating studio courses allows student to continue development of creative ideas and mastery of processes/media.

Prerequisite: <a href="Art 2601G">Art 2601G</a> and Art 2602G</a> Six semester hours of Art Survey (Ancient to Medieval, Gothic to Contemporary) or permission of instructor. WI

c. Revise the prerequisite for ART 4775 4775 ART Seminar in Twentieth-Century Art History and Criticism. (3-0-3) S. A critical understanding and evaluation of art, art-historical literature, and contemporary criticism, with emphasis on critics, artists and art of the post-World War II period. Prerequisite: Art 2601G and Art 2602G Six semester hours of Art Survey (Ancient to Medieval, Gothic to Contemporary) or permission of the instructor. WI
