Re: Request for Executive Action from the Department of Music

Requested Change:

The creation of a 3-credit, and in some cases, a 4-credit option for all graduate applied music courses as listed in "Catalog Language Changes" below.

Rationale:

This request is part of a large set of revisions for the Performance, Conducting, and Composition concentrations in the MA in Music program. With the proposed changes, students will enroll in a total of 14 credits of applied instruction in their primary area, instead of the 8 credits currently required. The increase in applied credit hours will more correctly reflect the amount of time students spend preparing for applied lessons. Students will enroll in 3 credits in each semester during the first year and 4 credits in each semester during the second year. The increase in applied credit during the second year will reflect the increase in work necessary to prepare for the Capstone Performance Project at the end of the second year. The Department wishes to retain the 1 and 2 credit option for students taking ½ hour secondary lessons.

The courses below have not undergone any revision that would require college, and university approval.
