Re: Request for Executive Action from the Department of History

Requested Change:

The History Department would like to add a US/Non-US (“US/NUS”) designation to HIS 4980, “The Vietnam War: An American and Vietnamese Ordeal,” as seen in “Catalog Language Changes” below.

Rationale for Change:

Every undergraduate course in HIS needs to carry a designation in their course description in order to allow students to easily see which courses count for their US electives, and which count for their non-US electives. Because the course at present does not have any such designation, it cannot count as one or the other for their majors without a waiver. No further changes to these courses are made.

Catalog Language Changes:

HIS 4980 - The Vietnam War: An American and Vietnamese Ordeal.

(3-0-3) On Demand. A reading, discussion, and writing course focusing on the Vietnam War (Second Indochinese War, 1965-1975) from an American, Vietnamese, and international perspective. Course may not be repeated. Restriction: Juniors (60 credits or more). WI **US/NUS**
