The following request was received from the Department of Early Childhood, Elementary, and Middle Level Education. I concur with the revision and that ask the changes be made by executive action. The effective date should be Fall 2015.

Requested Changes: to update prerequisites/concurrent enrollment requirements for ELE 4775.

Rationale for Changes: EdTPA requirements for Early Childhood place greater emphasis on the Literacy/Language connection. There is a stronger Literacy/Language alignment with ELE 4775 and ELE 3250 taken concurrently. There will be no change to course content.

1. **ELE 4775 - Language and Language Arts in Early Childhood.** (3-0-3) F, S. Normal language development in the young child. Techniques for specific language art skills in pre-school and primary teaching. Assessment of pupil growth and achievement in language.

ELE 2050. Concurrent enrollment in ELE 3225. Department requirements must be met including passing the TAP or ACT. ELE 3225 or permission of department chair. University Teacher Education and department requirements for enrollment must be met. Co-requisite: ELE 3250 and ELE 3281
