RE: Executive Action Item

The following request was received from the Department of Early Childhood, Elementary, and Middle Level Education. I concur with the revisions and that ask the changes be made by executive action. The effective date should be Fall 2015.

Requested Changes: to update the catalog listing for ELE/MLE 4855 to reflect that this is a variable credit course.

Rationale for Changes: We discovered that this variable credit course was not revised to meet the changes requested for financial aid purposes a few years ago. There will be no change to course content.
