MLE 4781 Topics in Junior High/Middle School Education

Rationale for Changes: These courses have long been offered face-to-face. Students are seeking more flexibility towards how courses are offered/completed. Moving these courses to an online delivery option is a step in that direction. The online delivery of the course will not change any course content and the integrity of the course will be maintained. All online courses will be taught by faculty who have completed the required training as established by EIU.
