The following request was received from the Department of Special Education. I concur with the change and ask that the revision be made by executive action.

Requested Changes: to modify the mission statement of the M.S. in Education in Special Education program. The requested effective date is as soon as possible.

Rationale: While the primary delivery method of this program is online, this is not our mission per se. Inserting this word can have a negative impact on external audience's perception of our program and it has the potential to exclude some potential candidates.

Program Mission: The mission of the online graduate program in Special Education is to prepare graduates for advanced professional practice with individuals with exceptional learning needs. Individuals may pursue additional Special Education endorsements which may include earning a supervisory endorsement, earning an LBS II for "Curriculum Adaptation Specialist" or "Behavior Intervention Specialist," or preparing to be a "Director" of Special Education.
