### **Rationale:**

- 1) On Demand offerings provide increased flexibility for both graduate students and the graduate coordinator as students with varying degree completion dates progress through the program. Also, as conversation continues about moving the program online, this is a preparatory step in that direction.
- 2) The Hybrid delivery option lends itself favorably to one-on-one interaction with the instructor for completing projects while also providing sufficient time for group interaction and lecture-style content.
