RE: Executive Action Taken at the CLAS Curriculum Committee Meeting on Sep 11, 2019

The following request was approved by executive action at the CLAS Curriculum Committee meeting on Sep 11, 2019. The request would be effective Spring 2020. I ask that similar action be taken at the Council on Graduate Studies.

## Requested change:

To change the course, GIS 5970z Special Topics in GIS to be able to be repeated more than once for credit; currently, it can only be taken once.

## **Rationale for change:**

GIS 5970z Special Topics in GIS is used in the Accelerated PSM program to count a graduate level course for both undergraduate and graduate degree programs. It is not a singular course as much as an umbrella course number to facilitate teaching different topics and having them count for the accelerated program. If left as non-repeatable, it will compromise the ability to offer students the accelerated option.
