RE: Executive Action Taken at the CLAS Curriculum Committee Meeting on Jan 19, 2022

The following request was approved by executive action at the CLAS Curriculum Committee meeting on Jan 19, 2022. The request would be effective Fall 2022. I ask that similar action be taken at the Council on Graduate Studies.

REQUEST #1: Course number change.

Requested Change: Adding an "A" designator to the course number to distinguish it from another course with the same designator.

Rational for change: Changing the course numbers to 6890A and 6890B will help limit confusion on the part of students and/or certification officers.

Current: PSY 6890: Advanced Practicum – Assessment and Intervention (Arr.-Arr.-3) (Credit/No Credit) Supervised experience in the assessment of and intervention with school-age children. Provides for integration and application of previous course work. **Prerequisites & Notes:** PSY 5890; PSY 5020; PSY 5022, and Enrollment in the School Psychology program. Credits: 3.

Proposed: PSY 6890A: Advanced Practicum – Assessment and Intervention (Arr.-Arr.-3) (Credit/No Credit) Supervised experience in the assessment of and intervention with school-age children. Provides for integration and application of previous course work. **Prerequisites & Notes:** PSY 5890; PSY 5020; PSY 5022, and Enrollment in the School Psychology program. Credits: 3.

REQUEST #2: Course number change

Requested Change: Adding a "B" designator to the course number to distinguish it from another course with the same designator.
