MAT 59502 - Thesis II

MAT 5810A - Topics in Geometry for Elementary/Middle School Teachers

MAT 5810B - Topics in History for Elementary/Middle School Teachers

MAT 5810D - Topics in Probability for Elementary/Middle School Teachers

MAT 5810E - Topics in Statistics for Elementary/Middle School Teachers

MAT 5810F – Topics in Number Theory for Elementary/Middle School Teachers

MAT 5810H – Topics in Computer Science for Elementary/Middle School Teachers

MAT 5810I - Topics in Mathematics for Elementary/Middle School Teachers I

MAT 5810I - Topics in Mathematics for Elementary/Middle School Teachers II

MAT 4870 – Data Structures and Algorithm Analysis

MAT 5035 - Topics in Computer Science

Rationale for Change:

MAT 4780 and MAT 5210 have either never been offered or have not been offered in the last ten years.

MAT 53352, MAT 53353, MAT 59501, and MAT 59502 are no longer needed as the Mathematics option of MA Mathematics graduate degree is being eliminated.

All the MAT 5810 courses are no longer needed as the Elementary/Middle Mathematics Education option of MA Mathematics graduate degree is being eliminated.

MAT 4870 and MAT 5035 are no longer offered and should have been eliminated when the department created a computer science designation for all computer science courses.
