Requested Change:

To revise the prerequisite language for SOC 4900, Current Issues in Sociology.

SOC 3050, 3620, and 3630; senior standing or permission of the instructor.

Revised Catalog Listing

Prerequisites & Notes:

SOC 3050, 3620, and 3630; sociology core GPA of 2.00; senior standing except with permission of the instructor.

Rationale for change: The sociology major requires that students achieve a 2.0 in a core group of eight classes including SOC 4900. Over the past several semesters, the department has witnessed a number of students enrolling SOC 4900 believing that they will be able to use this last class as a means of increasing their sociology core GPA to the required 2.00 or above. Typically, this does not happen, and student performance in this capstone class generally reveals deficiencies in one – or several – of our core sociology classes. This requested change will require that students address any deficiencies *before* enrolling in our capstone class.
