BIO 4960 - Wetland and Vascular Aquatic Plants. (2-3-3) F-odd-numbered years. The study of the taxonomy and ecology of wetland and aquatic plants, emphasizing those occurring in the Midwest. Field trips required.

BIO 1200G and either BIO 3322 or BIO 3612.

Proposed Catalog Description:

BIO 4960 - Wetland and Vascular Aquatic Plants. (2-3-3) F-odd-numbered years. The study of the taxonomy and ecology of wetland and aquatic plants, emphasizing those occurring in the Midwest. Field trips required.

BIO 1200G and either BIO 3322 or BIO 3612.

Rationale for change:
