RATIONALE:

This request is made to ease the articulation of transfer students into the undergraduate dietetics program by removing the prerequisite of CHM 2430 while maintaining a homogeneous group of learners due to the rigorous dietetic accreditation standards. The addition of CHM 1410/1415, which are prerequisites for CHM 2430, will help ensure the laboratory environment experiences and critical thinking skill necessary for this course. The addition of "permission of the instructor" will allow for more flexibility when allowing students into the course.
