

ACTION REQUESTED:

The Financial Literacy minor is being revised to update the requirements and selects that are offered. The program requirements have been reduced from 15 to 12 hours and the selects have been increased from 3 to 6 hours. Three Business courses (BUS 2101, 2710, and 3710) have been deleted and HSL 4775 Human Services Programming and Resource Navigation has been added as requirements. Previously, only two courses were offered as selects. This has been increased to eight courses and includes the following:
