

ACTION REQUESTED:

- Cross-list HST 2800 Health Education Research Methods I with HSL 2800 Health Education Research Methods I. **NOTE:** This action will result in a new course: HSL 2800: Health Education Research Methods I. The course that is currently numbered FCS 2800 will be renumbered to HSL 2820: Family Relationships per a separate executive action request.
- Change pre-requisite to HSC 2270 Community Health or HSL 2200 Introduction to Human Services Programs, and ENG 1002G

RATIONALE: Family & Consumer Sciences was realigned Fall 2018 and is no longer a stand-alone program. The FCS Family Services option is now in the Department of Human Services and Community Leadership in the College of Health and Human Services. FCS Family Services initiated a name change to Human Services Program Administration, and corresponding courses have been revised to align with the focus of the new department and revised degree.

Health Promotion offers HST 2800 Health Education Methods I. The course presents information needed for Human Services Program Administration. HST and HSL will collaborate on the offering of the course, maximizing faculty resources and enhancing collaboration across the college. The introductory course for each department will serve as the pre-req.
