Julie worked with high school technology teachers across the State, the Lumpkin School of Business Department Chair of Technology, and reviewed the new content exam to create the proposal. Julie stated the major will now have one (1) sub-area specific methods course, in addition to the general methods course. It is believed that taking the sub-area specific methods course will benefit the practicum experience.
