Re: Executive Action Request

The KSS department is requesting by executive action to delete the following courses from the EIU catalog. A rationale accompanies each course.

KSS 1440 – Lifeguarding. Not a required course for any KSS student, has not been taught for three years, the last offering did not meet minima.

KSS 2890 – Fitness for Life, Honors. Developed when KSS 2850 – Fitness for Life was a general education course, it is no longer, KSS no longer has an honors program.

KSS 3600 – Introduction to Elementary School Physical Education. This course was re-numbered to KSS 2400 – Introduction to Elementary School Physical Education in February of 2014.

KSS 3641 – Rhythms/Dance/Tumbling for Elementary Physical Education. Content from this course has been included in KSS 2400, course is no longer offered.
