Old Catalog Copy

KSS 1400 – Swimming (Beginning). For beginning swimmers only. Persons able to swim 45 feet should enroll in KSS 1410. May be repeated once to meet the minimum 120 semester hours toward graduation.

New Catalog Copy

KSS 1400 – Swimming. A class to promote swimming as a lifetime recreational and fitness activity. May be repeated once to meet the minimum 120 semester hours toward graduation. Ability to swim not required.
