The following prerequisite changes have been reviewed and approved by our Department curriculum committee. We ask they be approved by executive action.

Course #	Course Title	Current Prereqs	Proposed Revision	Notes
HST 3500	Human Sexuality	Junior status or above, or permission of the instructor	Remove prereq	Prerequisite was intended to insure that only upper level students who were presumably more mature could take the course. But so many students enter the University with substantial amounts of dual credit that their class is artificially inflated, which defeats the intent of the prerequisite.
HST 3750	Health Care Delivery Systems	ENG 1002G & HST 2270	ENG 1002G, HST 2270, & HST 2800 OR Admitted to the RN to BSN program	Adding HST 2800: Research Methods I. If students cannot successfully complete HST 2800, they do not have the necessary writing skills to be successful in the upper division core courses. Beginning Fall 2018, students in the RN to BSN completion program will be required to take one of three HST courses.
HST 3765	Principles of Epidemiology	HST 2270 or permission of the instructor	HST 2270 & HST 2800 OR Permission of the instructor	Adding HST 2800: Research Methods I. If students cannot successfully complete HST 2800, they do not have the necessary writing skills to be successful in the upper division core courses.
HST 4250	Planning Health Programs	HST 3700 with a grade of C or better	ENG 1002G, HST 2270, & HST 2800 OR Admitted to the RN to BSN program	Adding HST 2800: Research Methods I. If students cannot successfully complete HST 2800, they do not have the necessary writing skills to be successful in the upper division core courses. Adding other courses to ensure appropriate background preparation. Beginning Fall 2018, students in the RN to BSN completion program will be required to take one of three HST courses.
HST 4770	Health Services Administration	ENG 1002G, HST 2270, HST 3700, HST 3750, and Senior class status	ENG 1002G, HST 2270, HST 2800, HST 3700, & HST 3750 OR Permission of the instructor	Adding HST 2800: Research Methods I. If students cannot successfully complete HST 2800, they do not have the necessary writing skills to be successful in the upper division core courses. Dropping Senior class status because it has proved to be an unnecessary prerequisite.
