Jim Howley called the meeting to order.

Minutes

Aaron Mattox moved to approve the February 22, 2021 minutes. Kristen Holly seconded the motion. The minutes were approved with no changes and no abstentions.

MSED Removal in light of the Second Master’s degree policy: Dean Henderson shared the graduate school’s intent to remove the second master’s degree option in lieu of the new policy. There was discussion among members if licensure and accreditation was considered during the development of the new policy. Dean Henderson shared the policy would not supercede licensure and accreditation requirements. Dawn VanGunten motioned to approve and Jon Coleman seconded the motion. The proposal was approved unanimously with no changes.

Other Issues/Concerns: Christy shared about the initial assessment committee and their work towards the rubric revisions. The next step will be sharing the revisions with K-12 partners, then the revised rubrics will be shared with the COE Curriculum Committee. Dean Henderson shared about the proposed Illinois Bill which would allow community colleges to award Early Childhood degrees and there was discussion among members about the impact on BSED Early Childhood degrees.
