Election of Chair and Vice-Chair

Dawn VanGunten was approved as Chair by acclamation. Aaron Mattox was approved as Vice-Chair by acclamation.

Dawn VanGunten called the meeting to order.

Minutes

Aaron Mattox motioned to approve the March 22, 2021 minutes. Christy Hooser seconded the motion. The minutes were approved with no changes and one abstention.

Residency Hours Change Proposal: Dr. Jeff Stowell was seeking feedback on a proposal to change the university residency hour requirement. Dr. Stowell shared the benefit for transfer students to graduate in a timely manner and discussion among members included the proposal not impacting program hour requirements. The general consensus of the proposal was favorable. A formal proposal will be presented to the committee at a later date.

CTE: Business Major Changes: Dr. Julie Chadd presented the proposed changes to the CTE: Business Major. No additional hours have been added to the program. Christy Hooser motioned to approve the proposed changes and Aaron Mattox seconded. The proposal was passed unanimously and without abstentions.

Other Issues/Concerns:

Zoom Meetings: The committee has decided to meet via Zoom and will re-evaluate when necessary.

ISBE/Teacher Licensure Update: Dr. Lucas shared about discussion of a proposed MAT program in Secondary Education. The off-campus Elementary Education and Special Education cohorts in Champaign have 24 total students enrolled. The marketing for the Decatur program will begin soon and the proposed Danville cohort will be next. Dr. Lucas shared about the Early Childhood Education mandate and the consortium.
