- <sup>2</sup> At least one course must be culturally diverse. See catalog for selection.
- <sup>3</sup> Apply to Eastern one year prior to enrollment. Have official transcripts sent from college and from high school.
- <sup>4</sup> One semester hour of upper level credit will be waived to meet the 40 upper level hour requirement for graduation.
- <sup>5</sup> Must take Advanced Construction Safety as an elective for this to articulate.

NOTE Completion of the second semester of a single foreign language is a graduation requirement. Students are exempt if two full years of a high school foreign language is complete with a "C" average or better.
