## **EIU Civil Service Council Scholarship**:

Applicant must also have a GPA of 2.5 or above and in good academic standing at EIU <u>or</u> a high school senior accepted to EIU and enrolling in a minimum of 6 semester hours with class rank in the top 25 percent.
- 3. Financial need of the applicant will be considered and will need to be demonstrated during the application process.
