ATTN CLINICAL COUNSELING STUDENTS: Beginning August 1, 2018, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) introduced the implementation of Integrated Assessment and Treatment Planning (IATP). To support the application of the IATP, the Illinois Medicaid Comprehensive Assessment of Needs and Strengths (IM+CANS) was created as result of a partnership between HFS and the School of Social Work at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, and Chapin Hall at the University of Chicago. The IM+CANS is a model that integrates assessment and treatment planning into a single process.

If you are planning on doing your practicum or internship at a government agency, you will be required to partake in a mandatory training session designed to familiarize you with the IM+CANS. You can find the training schedule here -
