To support the application of the IATP, the Illinois Medicaid Comprehensive Assessment of Needs and Strengths (IM+CANS) was created as result of a partnership between HFS and the School of Social Work at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, and Chapin Hall at the University of Chicago. The IM+CANS is a model that integrates assessment and treatment planning into a single process.*
