## COUNSELING POSITIONS AVAILABLE

Three full time clinical positions are currently available. We are willing to wait until after graduation for the right candidate to begin. A Master's degree in a related field is preferred, but we will consider those with a Bachelor's degree in a related field and some relevant work experience.

The counselor openings are in our gender specific residential treatment program for adults, in our outpatient programs for adults and in our specialized women's program serving women and their children who are living onsite. Each of these positions will involve the provision of individual, group and family counseling, milieu management, case management and clinical documentation in an electronic medical record system. Clinical supervision and consultation are provided weekly and working as a team is valued and expected. Knowledge of child development, parenting skills and family dynamics would be an asset in the women's program location. Knowledge and understanding of gender specific concerns and of trauma would be helpful in all three positions.

CEAD Council holds a strong disease model of addiction, believes strongly in the need to provide treatment to the family as well as the person with a substance use disorder, and teaches about and refers to 12 step groups for ongoing support in recovery. Cognitive Behavioral Therapy is the preferred clinical approach. CEAD Council is located in Coles County.

Our agency has undergone significant changes in leadership in the last year and is vigorously involved in development of a healthy, supportive team atmosphere for staff and a respectful, trauma informed setting for clients.
