- 4. The new Illinois Teaching Standards go into place in 2012. We will need to align our programs with these standards.
- 5. The State Teacher Certification Board has been very busy. We will discuss any future changes and how they will impact our programs.
- 6. New Unit Assessment rubrics are out there and have been implemented.
