- 4. The ISBE is now requiring an online survey be completed when applying for licensure. This survey is required to finalize the licensure process.
- 5. Please remind students to use their legal name when establishing their ELIS accounts.
- 6. Please remind any students who have not met the TAP/ACT requirement that they can use super scoring.
- 7. A rule change effective in February 2018 the grade range for the CTE program will change to grades 6-12.
- 8. Dean Bower and Dr. Lucas recently met with a focus group of teacher education students to discuss their perceptions of teaching in rural schools.
- 9. Dean Bower and Dr. Lucas recently met with a group of our K-12 partner schools. The priorities of this meeting were recruitment and improving relationships with our partner schools. This group plans to meet every quarter. There are also plans to create 4-5 committees within this group to address issues/concerns. Dean Bower would like to have at least one COTE member to serve on each of the committees. He plans to send information on the committees to COTE members in January.
