The theme is intentionally broad; a CFP will be circulated in May 2020 and program finalized in August-September 2020. Keynote will focus on today's social studies classroom (use of technology, discussion of current and controversial events, etc.), and breakout sessions will highlight content and instructional strategies in the social studies disciplines of history, geography, economics, government, and psychology. Additional breakouts on news literacy and standards-based grading may be included, as will a strand of breakout sessions on implementing the new middle level civics law. The conference will be advertised to practicing middle and secondary social studies teachers as well as to preservice teachers at Eastern Illinois University and throughout central Illinois.
