You can use the verbs below, which cover the span of the taxonomy, for almost everything from lesson planning and rubric making, to doing curriculum mapping and more. It begins with Remembering (lower-order thinking skills, LOTS) and ends with Creating (higher-order thinking skills, HOTS).
