### 2016-2017 VERIFICATION OF 2015 TAX FILING EXTENSION

To verify income, students/parents must verify their income by utilizing the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to import tax information from the IRS into the FAFSA or by submitting a Tax Return Transcript obtained from the IRS. Income information must be verified even if the federal tax return has not been filed. Instructions for tax filers filing an extension are detailed below.

Eastern Illinois University has implemented a verification process to award some types of aid based upon estimated income information for students/parents with a tax filing extension. **Please provide the following documents:**

- **A copy of the IRS Form 4868 “Application for Automatic Extension of Time to File US Individual Income Tax Return” that was filed with the IRS for 2015 taxes**
- **A copy of the IRS approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension *if the individual requested an additional extension of the filing time for tax year 2015* AND**
- **Copies of all W-2 forms for each source of employment income received for tax year 2015 and, if self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of the individual’s AGI (Adjusted Gross Income) and the U.S. income tax paid for tax year 2015**
