This is a request under the U.S. Freedom of Information Act and the Illinois Freedom of Information Act.

I am requesting three things:

- 1) Redacted copies of your susceptibility lists (by disease category) of all students who have not provided proof of immunity, as specified in Section 694.110 of the College Immunization Code, for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 2) Your most recent annual summary report on college immunizations, as provided to the Illinois Department of Public Health, as specified in Section 694.120 of the College Immunization Code, for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 3) Redacted copies of all students' objections to immunizations on religious grounds, showing whether the objections were accepted or denied, as specified in Section 694.210 of the College Immunization Code, for the 2013-2014 school year.
