Abstract

This project attempted to, through a child-oriented narrative, display anthropogenic climate change and environmental destruction in a creative yet easily comprehensible and actively relatable fashion in an effort to simply and effectively appeal to a youth audience. The final iteration of the project, resembling a children's book and titled *Through Your Eyes and Mine*, embodies the ever-growing, quantifiable, human-influenced environmental issues endured today by highlighting four landmark identifiers that reflect humanity's human-caused environmental destruction, including negative impacts on rainforests, coral reefs, glaciers, and coastal communities. This project sought to translate the wealth of analytical data collected on these subjects to more readily identifiable terms and presenting the reality of these issues to its audience. Future work includes additional illustrations, edited text, and variation of the storyline.
