The purpose of an IHEC consultation visit is for campuses to enhance or strengthen their current programming, provide data to justify need for future programming, and to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations.

IHEC staff members are available to guide colleges and universities in assessment, planning, and evaluation of campus AODV prevention efforts through technical assistance and our assessment instruments developed for this project.

What can you expect during a consultation visit?

It's really a series of brief meetings with key staff and administrators that are scheduled as convenient throughout the day. As a result of these interviews, we find the common emerging themes and analyze our data to create a comprehensive report that becomes the sole property of the institution.

The benefits?

Better awareness and understanding of campus culture, how your current programming is perceived, effectiveness of your current efforts, what's working, what can be improved, and we identify strategies to help you take the "next step." This report has also been useful to inform your Biennial Review process, and maybe even enhance your campus relationships.
