

IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

PLEASE READ!

As of September 1, 2004, the United States Department of Homeland Security is requiring ALL new applicants for student visas to pay a congressionally mandated fee to cover the costs of operation of the Student and Exchange Visitor Program.

YOU MUST PAY THE FEE AND RECEIVE A RECEIPT BEFORE YOU APPLY FOR YOUR STUDENT VISA AT A U.S. EMBASSY OR CONSULATE. THE RECEIPT MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE EMBASSY OFFICIAL DURING THE VISA INTERVIEW. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THE RECEIPT, YOU WILL NOT BE AWARDED A STUDENT VISA.

To pay the fee with a credit card (recommended):

- **Go to the following website:**

- **The receipt can be printed from your computer.**

To pay by mail, go to the same website:

- **Fill out form I-901, print it and send it along with your payment to the address specified on the website.**
- **If you choose this method, please remember that it will take several days for you to receive your receipt. You should plan to use a courier service such as DHL or another carrier for prompt service.**
