The Sports Media Relations minor provides insights into the roles and duties performed by sports media professionals. Students take courses that enable them to examine and practice skills related to the fundamentals of sports media relations, which includes working with the media, athletes and coaches, managing crisis situations, recording statistics, writing game reports, marketing teams, organizing press conferences, and managing game events.
