Responsibilities

- Supporting daily maintenance, organization, and cleanliness of training facilities
- Assisting with **data entry, tracking, and upkeep**
- Supporting team logistics, setup, breakdown, and transitions
- Completing additional duties as assigned by the Head Strength & Conditioning Coach
