
GSD




Diva Drag Show

EIU PRIDE



A man who is physically, romantically, and emotionally attracted to other men. Also used to describe someone that is homosexual.






<u>Gender</u>

 The irrational fear of homosexuals, homosexuality or any behavior, belief or attitude of self or others which does not conform to rigid sex and gender-role stereotypes. The extreme behavior of homophobia is violence against gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender persons.





Sexual orientation is who you are physically, spiritually, and emotionally attracted to, based on their sex/gender in relation to your own.








Lesbian

Sexual Orientation

SAME LOVE SAME RIGHTS A person's physical, romantic and/or emotional attraction to another person

Sex

A categorization of male or female according to sex hormones, chromosomes, reproductive organs, etc.





Transgender

An umbrella term used for people whose gender identity is different from their sex assigned at birth

Transphobia

The irrational fear of and hostility towards people who are transgender or otherwise transgress traditional gender norms
