My dear Madam:

The only advantage we can offer over any other normal school is the woman's building, to which you have referred.

There is no markedly distinctive religious element in the building. The Young Women's Christian Association hold in that building weekly a religious meeting. It is proper to say, however, that there is nothing to discourage religious life. Four dollars a week is the cost of living there.

I should hardly think it wise, however, for you to change your daughter's school, if she is doing well where she is. We accept grades from any other state normal school.
