### DAVID BOGGS, PANTHER MARCHING BAND DIRECTOR AND ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF BANDS

Prior to coming to Eastern, David Boggs served as the Director of Athletic Bands at McKendree University for 20 years. He was the Director of the Marching Bearcat Band and Pep Bands, served as the Director of the Music in Our Schools Program, and coordinated many aspects of music student recruitment. He was one of the chief architects in designing the music education, music business, and jazz performance degree programs. He pioneered the Young People's Concerts (three different series of concerts) and oversaw the Preview of Champions and Small Band Marching Band Festivals. He also managed a multitude of additional music education-based clinics, concerts, and events, including the DCI St. Louis Show, the Midwest Percussion Camp, and Phantom Regiment Summer Music Camps.



Prior work experience includes Director of Bands at Rolling Meadows and Newton High Schools. He worked in the music departments of Indiana University and Purdue University, served as the Corps Director for Music City Drum and Bugle Corps, and was on the staff of Cadets Drum and Bugle Corps and Music City Drum Corps. Past marching experience included being a former marching member of The Cavaliers Drum Corps. He was also a clinician for the Smith-Walbridge Drum Major Camp for ten years.

#### **COURTNEY ST. JOHN, COLOR GUARD**

Originally from Mattoon, Courtney St. John began taking dance classes at the age of 3. A product of Mattoon High School, St. John started the colorguard for that ensemble in 2007 and performed all four years in the fallguard and winterguard. While pursuing a Sociology degree from EIU, St. John marched all 4 years with the Panther Marching Band and performed for 3 years with winterguard, and 2 years with Avidity Independent. St. John is the Effingham High School Color Guard Director and the Mattoon High School Winterguard Weapon Tech. 
