ABOUT THE OPERA/MUSICAL SCENE PRODUCTION

"The Seasons of Love" features selected songs from a wide spectrum of opera and musical scenes. The synopsis is written by Dr. Julie Park, the associate professor of voice at EIU. The story portrays various happenings by love seekers, who are guests visiting the bar, Seasons of Love, on Thursday nights.

Synopsis

Scene I

The waiter at Seasons of Love bar is preparing for guests on Thursday night. He already feels tired since he usually deals with rowdy customers on Thursday nights.

Scene II

Don Giovanni, renowned as a playboy, enters the bar eagerly anticipating encounters with new romantic prospects. Eileen, a young and charming woman visiting the bar for the first time. Don Giovanni wastes no time in charming her, serenading her with "Deh, vieni alla finestra" (O come to the window, beloved). Eileen quickly falls for his charms and responds with "I am a little bit in love," joining him in dance.

Scene III

Papagena, who has connected with the waiter on Instagram, decides to surprise him by visiting the bar. Their instant connection blossoms into love as they sing the duet "Pa-Pa-Pa-Papageno" and Juliette's solo "Je veux vivre" (I want to live).

Scene IV

Depressed and lonely guy Sam comes to the bar, expressing his loneliness through singing.

Scene V

Musetta, renowned for her beauty, enters the bar and sings "Quando me'n vo" (When I go along). Every man in the bar is enchanted by her beauty, and she delights in the admiration.

Scene VI

Carmen, another renowned beauty, arrives at the bar upset because her rival, Musetta, is there enjoying her time with all the guys. Carmen sings "L'amour est un oiseau rebelle" (Love is a rebellious bird) and talks about what the love is. The tension between Carmen and Musetta escalates, leading to a fight among all the people in the bar.

ABOUT THE OPERA/MUSICAL SCENE PRODUCTION

Scene VII

The waiter calms down the people, and Sarah just wakes up during the fight. Nobody notices until she hiccups, having been under the table while drunk. She sings "If I were a bell" and talks to people about falling in love, comparing her emotions to the sound of a bell ringing.

Scene IX

The married man, Petruchio, secretly escapes from home and comes to the bar. He sings "Where is the life that late I led" and laments the loss of his bachelor life and misses all the girls that he met in the past.

Scene X

Almirena, burdened by depression and despair, seeks refuge in the bar, expressing her sorrow through "Lascia ch'io pianga" (Let me weep).

Scene XI

A merry, happy girl Maria arrives, exuding joy as she sings "I Feel Pretty." Despite teasing from her friends, she revels in the happiness of being loved by a remarkable man, Tony.

Scene XII

Maria realized that Tony has already been at the bar. They declare their love for each other and sing a love duet "Tonight". As the evening draws to a close, the waiter announces the end of the night, bidding farewell to the patrons as they exchange goodbyes, marking the conclusion of the show.

Dr. Julie Junghwa Park is an active concert artist and opera singer who has performed with the New York Lyric Opera in New York City, Castleton Music Festival under the direction of Maestro Lorin Maazel, the National Music Opera Theater ensemble in Kassel, Germany and Salon Opera festival in Seoul, South-Korea. Dr. Park made her solo recital debut at Weill recital hall at Carnegie hall in 2012 where she also performed Winners' concerts of the Golden era of romantic music international competition, and BAIVC international competition as first prize winner.
