He taught at 3 time BOA champion Avon High School in 2007. He's been a staff member of the Illini Drumline(The University of Illinois) since 1993 and Instructed Iowa State's drumline from 2004-2006. Ian was also the head clinician at The Smith Walbridge Percussion Camp from 2004-2014. Ian teaches privately at The Blue Room Percussion Studio in Champaign, IL where his hardworking, blue collar approach is emphasized. Students are giving real life skills so they can survive and thrive in the world of performing and teaching. He is a proud Evans Drumheads and Promark sticks artist.

## PATRON SERVICES GUIDELINES

### **Usher Staff**

Ushers are located at the entrance of the venue. If you have a question or a problem, please let them know and they will contact the House Manager.

### **Ticket Policies**

Please note that all ticket sales are final, and refunds will not be given.

### **Late Arrival**

During classical concerts, late seating will only take place during the first convenient pause in the program.

During jazz, folk, world, or pop concerts, late seating is more casual, but ushers may ask you to wait to be seated between pieces. Please check with an usher regarding when you may enter the venue.

### **Mobile Devices, Photography and Recording**

Please turn off all light-illuminating or sound-emitting devices. Mobile phone use is strictly prohibited inside all venues. Text-messaging and the taking of photographs or videos by phone are not permitted.

The use of cameras - with or without flash - and recording devices is a violation of copyright law and discourteous to other audience members.

Failure to comply will result in being asked to leave the performance without a refund.

### **Doctor and Parent Emergency Calls**

If you are a medical professional/parent with a sitter at home, please put your phone on silent and wait to take the call until you are out of the performance venue.

### **No Smoking**

Eastern Illinois University is a tobacco-free campus. Smoking of any kind, including electronic cigarettes, is prohibited on all university property.

### **Food and Beverages**

Food is not allowed inside any of the venues. Only beverages in the special Doudna drink cup, with a secured lid, are permitted in the venues.

### **Accessibility**

Special seating areas for wheelchair accessibility are available. Contact the Box Office in advance to secure a seat in these areas. Audio amplification is available for the hearing-impaired free of charge. A driver's license or other identification is all that is required for deposit.

### **In the Event of an Emergency**

Emergency exits may be found outside of the venue and are marked accordingly. The lighted "Exit" sign nearest your seat is the shortest route out of the building.
