GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS IN MUSIC 2018-2019

DEGREES: EIU offers a Master of Arts in Music with the following Concentrations: Performance (Instrumental, Vocal, Keyboard);

Conducting (Choral, Orchestral, and Wind); and Composition. Students may pursue jazz studies through the Instrumental Performance Concentration. For more information, visit http://www.eiu.edu/musicgrad/.

DUTIES: Depending on the candidate's skills, duties may include assistance with:

STIPEND: approximately \$870 per month for nine months, renewable for one year, with tuition waiver for 9-16 credit hours per

semester (Fall & Spring).

QUALIFICATIONS: Completion of an undergraduate degree in music or its equivalent is required. Candidates must be accepted into the

University and the Department of Music in order to be considered for an assistantship.
