


Quick Guide to: Desire to Learn (D2L)



Assessment: When you select the “Assessment” tab, a drop down menu will appear. You will only regularly use a few of these tabs. If your instructor wants an assignment submitted online, it will be turned in via the “Dropbox” tab. If your professor posts quizzes online, they can be accessed through the “Quizzes” tab under assessment. Some professors regularly update grades to D2L, so you can see your grade on assignments and overall in the “Grades” section.



Widgets & Apps: At the top of the screen, you will see 3 widgets. If a professor uploads anything, the bell on the right will have a small yellow dot in the bottom right. If your professor would prefer you reach out to them via D2L with any questions you have, select the envelope on the left and select “email” from the dropdown menu. If you want notifications directly sent to your phone without opening D2L, you can also download the “Brightspace Pulse” app (works on both Apple and Android phones). Search/select “Eastern Illinois University” as the institution, and use your D2L login credentials to log in.
