Know all men by these presents that we Nath
 an Cromwell and _____ are held
 and firmly bound unto the Governor of the State
 of Illinois and his successor in office in the full
 sum of three hundred Dollars for the paymen
 t of which we bind our selves our heirs execu
 tors and administrators sealed with our seals
 and dated this _____ day of December 1829

now the condition of the above obliga
 tion is such that whereas Nathan Cromwell
 did at the County Commissioners Court for
 Sangamon County held on the first mon
 day in December 1829 obtain a license
 from said Court to keep a publick house
 at his store in the Garden Prairie to continue
 one year from the 5th day Dec 1829

Now if the said Cromwell at all times
 be of good behavior and observe all the laws
 which are or shall be in force relating to
 tavern or inn keepers and keep meat and
 lodging for at least four persons over &
 above his common family and thatting &
 provender for their horses then this obligation
 to be void otherwise to remain in full force
 and virtue
