Justice to Children. Loyalty to Women.

Chicago, Ills., April 16 1890

To the Mayor and Common Council of  
Chicago.

Gentlemen:

To help our sanitary police in their work of enforcing Section 1357 of the Health Ordinances relating to child labor, we urge your body to enact an ordinance to the following effect.

That no child shall be employed for hire without furnishing a certificate signed jointly by the Board of Education and the Health Department. Such certificate comprising 1st. An affidavit of the parent or guardian of the child giving its age, place and date of birth:

2d. A <sup>certificate</sup>~~an affidavit~~ of the city physician certifying that the child is in proper physical condition to work

3d. A <sup>certificate</sup>~~an affidavit~~ of the Board of Education certifying that the child has complied with the compulsory education law during the twelve months next preceding the time of application for employment.

That such certificate or certified copy thereof shall be kept on file in all places where children are employed and be subject to inspection by the sanitary officers.
