

This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of March in
the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and
twenty Between William A. Baird Sheriff of St. Clair
County of the one part and Thomas Estes of the other
part Witnesseth Where as on the thirteenth day of
July in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred
and nineteen a certain writ of the State of Illinois
of fieri facias did issue forth out of the Circuit Court for
the County of St. Clair to the Sheriff of St. Clair County
directed reciting that Where as at a Circuit Court begun
and held at the Town of Belleville on the second Monday
of June in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight
hundred and nineteen a certain Samuel Lee by the
Judgement of the said Court recovered against a certain
Daniel Sullivan late of the County aforesaid for the
sum of one hundred and eighty dollars and forty six cents
and one half cent the said Sheriff was then fore commanded
that of the State of Daniel Sullivan the bail of Samuel
Davidson being in his bailiwick he should cause to
be made and lived the debt damages costs and charges
aforesaid and that he should have that money at the
Clerks office of our said Circuit Court within thirty
days from the date thereof to be paid to the said
Samuel Lee the debt damages costs and charges aforesaid
and that the said Sheriff should also have there
there that writ and, Where as also the said writ
came to the hands of the said Sheriff and in pursuance
of the Command therein contained the said Sheriff
did the same upon the Estate of the within named Daniel
Sullivan on the twenty fourth day of July in the year of
our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and nineteen which he
subsequently released by tendering the within Replevin
Bond and Security according to law David Coons his security
and Where as on the seventh day of January in the year
of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and twenty a certain
other writ of fieri facias did issue out of the Circuit
Court for St. Clair County on the Replevin Bond taken
as aforesaid directed to the Sheriff of St. Clair County
aforesaid Commanding him that of the Estate
of Daniels Sullivan and David Coons he should cause to
be made the sum of one hundred and thirteen dollars
and ten cents being the amount of a Bond taken by the
Sheriff of St. Clair County aforesaid upon an Execution
issued out of the Circuit Court for St. Clair County
upon a Judgment obtained therein by Samuel Lee
by virtue of an act entitled "an act for the relief
of debtors" which Bond returned to the Clerks office
bears date the twenty fourth day of July last also eight
dollars and one half cent for this writ and the Sheriff legal
fees and charges thereon and that he should have
that money at the Clerks office of our said Circuit
Court within thirty days from the date thereof and so

well that writ with due return thereon to render
to the said Samuels his debt and damages aforesaid
and, whereas also the said writ came to the hands of the
said Sheriff and in pursuance of the command therein
contained the said Sheriff laid the same upon a certain tract
or parcels of land, being and containing sixty acres more or
less of land belonging to him the said Daniel Sullivan called
and known by the name of the upper ferry lying and being
in St. Clair County aforesaid on the East bank of the
Mississippi river opposite the upper end of the Town of
St. Louis in the Missouri State or Territory being part of
the original cession of land of Joachim Caillieus of
one hundred acres of land described as above stated and
whereas also a certain other writ of Venditionis praescriptae
out of the Clerk's office of the Circuit Court for St.
Clair County on the Eighteenth day of February in the
year of our said one thousand eight hundred and twenty,
directed to the Sheriff of the County of St. Clair Com-
= mending him that he should upon the Public sale the
= ending him that he should upon the Public sale the
= Sullivan and David Coons to the value of one hundred
and seventy dollars and thirty seven cents which according
= to the command of the said writ he was commanded of
the land of the said Sullivan so taken in execution and
which did remain in his hands unsold for the want of
time as by the writ before mentioned and as ~~the~~ has
= certified to satisfy Samuels his the said sum of one
hundred and seventy dollars thirty seven cents whereof
the said he hath recovered execution against the said
Daniel Sullivan and David Coons by virtue of a Judge
= ment in the said Court and that he should have
that money at the Clerk's office with thirty seven cents
half cent costs of this writ of an said Court within
thirty days from the date thereof and that he have
them then that writ and whereas also after due notice
being given of the same according to law the said Sheriff
did on the Eighteenth day of March in the year of
our said one thousand eight hundred and twenty, at
the hour of Twelve of the clock of said day expose
to Public sale the said tract or parcels of land being
sixty acres more or less as before described to the highest
bidder the said tract or parcels of land so taken in
execution and described as aforesaid containing sixty acres
more or less and that the he the for named Thomas Estes
he came the highest and best bidder and purchased of
the land as aforesaid and that the same was struck
off to the writ the mentioned Thomas Estes and he the said
Thomas Estes being the highest and best bidder for
the sum of nineteen dollars and fifty cents
